## "The Forest Race 2011" reaches new heights!



The NVMC Committee has made a risky choice - they have fallen for the suggestion of a bone-headed Alvdaler!

Therefore, HQ for the "Forest Race 2011" will Grimsbu Turistsenter in Folldal municipality from 1st - 3rd July 2011.

Here, there's loads of space, from tent plots with self-service cooking, to full board motel rooms. A communal dormatory is recommended for anyone who gets nervous at the thought of being "all alone". Here's what's on offer:

Grimsbu Tourist Center is a family business which has been built up from 1963 to the present day and has the following offer:

## Dining

Cafeteria (Kafeteria) serving breakfast (Kr. 75 per person), lunch (from Kr. 70 - Kr. 150) and dinner (from Kr. 80 - Kr. 160).

We can set up a dinner-buffet where everyone can help themselves (Kr. 175 per person) seating 120 people.

In addition to this we have function room with an open bar if needed. The room fits 80 people and is fully licenced.

## Accommodation

We have five motel rooms. Single rooms cost Kr. 590, and double rooms cost Kr. 690 per night.

There are seven high-standard 6 bed cabins (hytter). Price Kr. 830 per night. Also, there are two medium - high standard 2 bed cabins. Price Kr. 730 per night. In addition to this, we have eight medium sized 4 bed cabins without shower and toilet, instead using the sanitation facilities in the main building. Price Kr. 470 per night.

Seven small 2 bed cabins without shower or toilet. Price Kr. 370 per cabin, per night. 100 beds in total.

We have space for 60 caravans/campers plus tents. Carriages with electricity cost Kr. 200 per day.

Tent plots cost Kr. 90 each.

The Tourist Center has a long experience with this type of arrangement. The OTC (Offroad Touring Club www.otc-mc.org), among others, has had it's annual arrangement here.

Saturday's race starts at 10 am, and Norway's longest seter (mountain summer farm) valley, Einunndalen. According to many it is also the finest seter valley. Approx. 80 km with numerous possibilites for interesting "pit stops" to sly competitions, amazing food, enjoyment of the breath-taking nature at many well maintained mountain farms with their attractive meadows and even more attractive milkmaids. Coffee and something on the side is included in the race subscription. Be sure to remember your camera, binoculars, fishing rods, etc. as we will spend most of the day here.

We expect to arrive at Grimsbu about 7 pm and with the presentation of prizes for the lucky ones around 8 pm, there should be ample time afterwards for carcass maintenance. Those that want to roam freely at the dinner buffet should reserve a seat when ordering accommodation. 7 pm should be a reasonable time for this.

The location lies approx. 660 above sea level, and with the races highest point nearly at twice the height, could this be named "The all time high Forest Race"?

Registration is through NVMC and prices before 1st June, 2011 for bike and driver is Kr. 200, passengers Kr. 50.

After 1st June up to one hour before the race starts, the rates will be Kr. 300, and Kr. 75.

Rescue teams, with or without the relevant diplomas, will of course, be on hand to help the unlucky ones.

## How to find us?

If you travel from the South on the E6, I can recommend RV 27 from Ringebu, over the mountain to Enden, and then take the National tourist road to Folldal. Once there, you swing right on to the RV 29 and 10 km later you are in Grimsbu. Whether you travel from the North or South on the E6, take RV 29 at Hjerkinn, and

Whether you travel from the North or South on the E6, take RV 29 at Hjerkinn, and 40 km later you'll arrive there.

If it is RV3 which you will use, take RV 29 towards Hjerkinn, two kilometers North from central Alvdal, and drive 30 km and you are there.

A great landmark for you is the newly restored funky BP gas station straight across the road from the camping site.
